NOTICE OF HEARING ON PROPOSED SETTLEMENT

Pursuant to Rule 23 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and an Order of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Indiana, Hammond Division, this notice is to advise you that there will be a fairness hearing to determine whether, in a class action brought on behalf of all persons eligible for paratransit services under the Americans with Disabilities Act who are or will be paratransit riders in Lake County, Indiana, the proposed settlement with defendant Northwest Indiana Community Action Corporation (formerly known as Lake County Economic Opportunity Council) (“NWICAC”) is fair, reasonable and adequate, and should be approved by the Court.

The fairness hearing is scheduled to take place at 2 p.m. on May 22, 2007, at the Federal Courthouse for the United States District Court for the Northern District of Indiana, Courtroom of the Honorable Judge Phillip P. Simon, 5400 Federal Plaza, in Hammond Indiana.
